#### Year 12 Achievements Snapshot

Certificate of Merit and Certificate of Distinction awards recognise student achievement in their WACE and are dependent on the degree of difficulty of the courses and programs undertaken, together with the students level of achievement.

A certificate of Merit or a Certificate of Distinction is awarded to each eligible student who, in their last three consecutive years of Senior Secondary School WACE enrolment, accumulates: 150-189 points - a Certificate of Merit 190-200 points - a Certificate of Distinction.

In 2020 Leah Hart was a recipient of the Certificate of Distinction. Jessica Bardsley, Jessica Elliot, Callum Marin, Jess-Rachel Stevens and Hallie Zilko received a Certificate of Merit. Very worthy recipients. Congratulations!

Five students in the ATAR cohort achieved an ATAR of 90 or above. This means that they are ranked at being in the top 10 percent of the state. Two in every three students of the ATAR cohort achieved an ATAR of 80 or better.

LWLC was ranked 51 out of all schools offering ATAR in WA for our median ATAR results. This is our best result since 2010.

These results are incredible and reflect the high quality of teaching and learning at Living Waters Lutheran College.


