

## Behaviour Management in Primary School (from the Primary Diary)

Managing student behaviour in Primary School years is about establishing a positive learning environment

## Students are assisted to:

- recognise and regulate emotions.
- Establish positive relationships.
- Make responsible decisions.
- Work collaboratively.
- Respect others.

## Behaviour by a student that compromises the Positive Learning Environment is categorised into

- Inappropriate behaviour (general).
- Unacceptable spontaneous behaviour.

## **Behaviour Management Framework**

Step 1	
Establish a positive classroom environment	<ul><li>Establish classroom rules</li><li>Develop with class</li></ul>
Step 2	
Actions for inappropriate behaviour	<ul> <li>Reminder of classroom rules.</li> <li>Emotional regulation strategies employed</li> </ul>
Step 3	
Actions for continued inappropriate behaviour	<ul> <li>Referral to Pastoral Care Coordinator</li> <li>Use of restorative questioning and RULER strategies.</li> </ul>
Step 4	,
Actions for significant incident involving threatening or violent behaviour towards others.	Referral to Head of School
Step 5	
Actions for repeated significant incident involving threatening or violent behaviour towards others.	<ul> <li>Removal of student from the group environment- in school supervision by Head of School</li> <li>Parents informed</li> <li>Individual Student Engagement Plan to be reviewed</li> </ul>
