



## Behaviour Management in Primary School (from the Primary Diary)

Managing student behaviour in Primary School years is about establishing a positive learning environment

Students are assisted to:

- recognise and regulate emotions.
- Establish positive relationships.
- Make responsible decisions.
- Work collaboratively.
- Respect others.

**Behaviour by a student that compromises the Positive Learning Environment is categorised into**

- Inappropriate behaviour (general).
- Unacceptable spontaneous behaviour.

### Behaviour Management Framework

Behaviour Management Primary School (2-6)	
<b>Step 1</b>	
Establish a positive classroom environment	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Establish classroom rules</b></li> <li>• <b>Develop with class</b></li> </ul>
<b>Step 2</b>	
Actions for inappropriate behaviour	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Reminder of classroom rules.</b></li> <li>• <b>Emotional regulation strategies employed</b></li> </ul>
<b>Step 3</b>	
Actions for continued inappropriate behaviour	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Referral to Pastoral Care Coordinator</b></li> <li>• <b>Use of restorative questioning and RULER strategies.</b></li> </ul>
<b>Step 4</b>	
Actions for significant incident involving threatening or violent behaviour towards others.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Referral to Head of School</b></li> </ul>
<b>Step 5</b>	
Actions for repeated significant incident involving threatening or violent behaviour towards others.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Removal of student from the group environment- in school supervision by Head of School</b></li> <li>• <b>Parents informed</b></li> <li>• <b>Individual Student Engagement Plan to be reviewed</b></li> </ul>
