



Netball Program Scholarship

Frequently Asked Questions

Who is eligible for the scholarship?

The student has to be of 'Association Level' ability. That is defined as either:

- Played at the Fuel to Go and Play Association Championships, or
- Judged to be of 'Association Level' ability by a suitably qualified selector or Netball Program Coordinator.

What year level does the scholarship cover?

Netball Scholarships are available for students from Year 7 upwards. (If the student enrolls into the college in Year 11 they will only be eligible for a one year scholarship as the netball program runs from Year 7-12)

Can new and existing students receive a basketball scholarship?

The Scholarship is available to students new to the College AND existing students as long as they qualify when they join the program.

How will I receive the scholarship funds?

The Scholarship is delivered to the family as a credit against their school fees account.

What is the Scholarship Value?

The total value of the Scholarship is \$3,000. This is split over the first two years that the student is in the Netball Program. I.e., \$1,500 per year for 2 years.

Does my daughter still qualify for a scholarship if the above criteria is met and they enrol part way through the year?

If a student joins the College or the Program part way through the year, then they still get the full \$1,500 in their first school year and \$1,500 in the second school year, i.e., no pro-rata will take place.

What happens if my son/daughter leave the school and they are on a netball scholarship?

If a student leaves the Program part-way during a school year, the Scholarship will be revoked on a pro-rata basis. E.g., if a student joins the program at the start of the year and receives a \$1,500 scholarship credit to the family's fee account, but subsequently leaves the program mid-year, half of that year's scholarship credit will be removed from the family's fee account.
